

Sewing Accessories Haberdashery Bags What to Do?

Find a box about the size of a wine box (6 bottle) or bag and then collect all the items listed below:

- 15 reels coloured cotton thread (including white & black) in a bag
- 6 zips
- 1 bag assorted buttons
- 1 buckle
- 1 set safety pins (about 6)
- 1 box of pins
- 2 packets of sewing needles
- 1 thimble
- 1 set of knitting needles (includes crochet hook etc)
- 2 metres of elastic
- 2 pieces of stiffening
- 1 set press studs
- 1 set hook and eyes
- 4 tape measures
- 2 sets of bias binding
- 4 pieces of lace
- 4 pieces of trim
- 1 Needle threader
- 4 pieces of ribbon (if available)

Plus any other items available

2 crochet thread
2 embroidery wool
6 embroidery silks

You can also add a bag of knitting wool. Please try to get enough of the same type (at least thickness) to knit an item such as a baby's jacket or shoes.

Place all the items neatly into the box. Please make sure that the box is full (so we don't ship empty space!) and that the items will not fall out of any holes in the box. Alternatively you can put them into a strong carrier bag which is tied at the top.

Please note: The above list is an 'ideal' selection of haberdashery that could be put into a kit. Sometimes some of these items may be in short supply and it is perfectly acceptable to either reduce the quantity or even omit it altogether. It is important to remember that the accessory bag is intended as a start up for the group. It must not contain huge amounts of fabric or other new items as this could cause questions to be asked by customs officers which may affect future shipping.
